Yamada Yoshimitsu Shihan started his practice in 1955 when he was 18 years old, at the Aikikai Hombu Dojo in Tokyo. In 1964 he was invited to present Aikido in New York, where he settled becoming the chief instructor of New York Aikikai. President of the United States Aikido Federation and of the South American Aikido Federation, he is a leading figure for many dojo also in Europe, where he has been teaching regularly for over 30 years – often together with his friend and sempai Tamura Nobuyoshi Shihan, recently passed away.

:: Inscriptions

Practitioners of any rank and affiliation are welcome. When filling the inscription form, participants must declare to be fully insured for Aikido practice during the seminar, waiving any liability from the organizers in case of accident.

:: Early inscription

Two deadlines are scheduled for early reservation, implying a reduction of participation fees.

• Within April 30 The participation fee for the complete seminar is reduced from 80 to 60 Euro.

• Within May 21 The participation fee for the complete seminar is reduced from 80 to 70 Euro.
